From the Pastor

Kids are starting to bring their friends to Wednesday and Sunday school with them and on the 23rd, Lutherans Outdoors joined us as we celebrated Camping Night. Our new church council and boards had very productive meetings and are planning and implementing lots of exciting ministries. We began our new program of having Nametag Worship on the 3rd week of each month and I keep seeing lots of new faces at all of our worship services. Speaking of worship, attendance appears to be going up and your financial gifts to the church were as high in March as they have been in quite some time.

In the Mediterranean climate, March is the beginning of nicer weather and calmer seas. FEBRUARY EXECUTIVE COUNCIL RECAP

The Canton Lutheran Church Executive Council is excited to start a new year! The 3 Church Boards

(Welcome & Witness; Mission & Ministry; and Stewardship of Resources) along with the Executive Council are going to work hard together to bring exciting new things to the congregation this year. The main goals are to **improve communication** and **increase participation**. These goals were discussed at the first council retreat the first weekend in February. Council members will continue to discuss and work on these goals throughout the year through the work of the Church Boards. Using the Stewardship of Resource Board's motto of **Everybody's Got Something to Offer**, CLC's Church Council hopes to identify talents in congregation members and encourage them to get involved.

On Sunday, February 26, the congregation will lift up hunger ministries with **Our Hands Together Sunday**. Dakota Roads will perform during worship and following worship there will be a potluck. Council members will bring all the hot dishes and congregation members will be asked to bring salads and desserts.

During the first meeting of the year of CLC's Executive Council, council members followed up on the council retreat and Annual Congregational Meeting.

Welcome and Witness, chaired by Patty Kroger reported on **Our Hands Together Sunday**. They have invited the Bishop to be at worship on that Sunday and he will be preaching. They have also designated this as the first name-tag Sunday for congregation members to get to know each other better again. Name tags will be at all entrances. Bud Steensland will be recognized during worship for all the work he has done with the Food Pantry and his donation of the sound system. Teresa Nygaard will also be installed as a SD Synod Mission Interpreter.

The Council will be asking three members to be on a task force to look at the constitution and by-laws. Names were proposed and these three members will be asked if they would be interested. The congregation was told by the ELCA the current constitution is not in compliance with their regulations. The Council feels

this should be changed to be in compliance with the ELCA.

All three committees will talk about ideas for the congregational tithe from the parsonage sales. The congregation decided at the annual meeting to tithe \$24,000 to an organization or project the congregation chooses. The council will begin researching options to propose to the congregation.

The final item discussed by the council was the funds from the parsonage sales. Two separate accounts will be set up for building repairs and for ministry projects. The treasurer will look into options to see if the money should be put into a savings account or rolling CD.

MARCH EXECUTIVE COUNCIL RECAP

The Executive Council met on Wed., March 9.

At the annual meeting, the congregation decided to put money aside from the parsonage sales for building needs and ministry projects. The executive council established a CD to set aside \$100,000 for building needs and a savings account with \$67,000 for ministry projects.

A task force is still being put together to look at the constitution and by-laws of the congregation. So far, Brenda Ask and Jonathan Toso have agreed to be a part of the task force. One more member will be asked to join.

Welcome and Witness reported they will have "name tag Sunday" the third week of every month.

Mission and Ministry is promoting the ELCA's Buck a Chick program for World Hunger.

The Stewardship Board is working on finding volunteers for tellers on Sundays and mowers for the lawn. They will also look into resealing the front door of the church.

The whole church council will meet on Sunday, April 3 at 11:30 a.m.

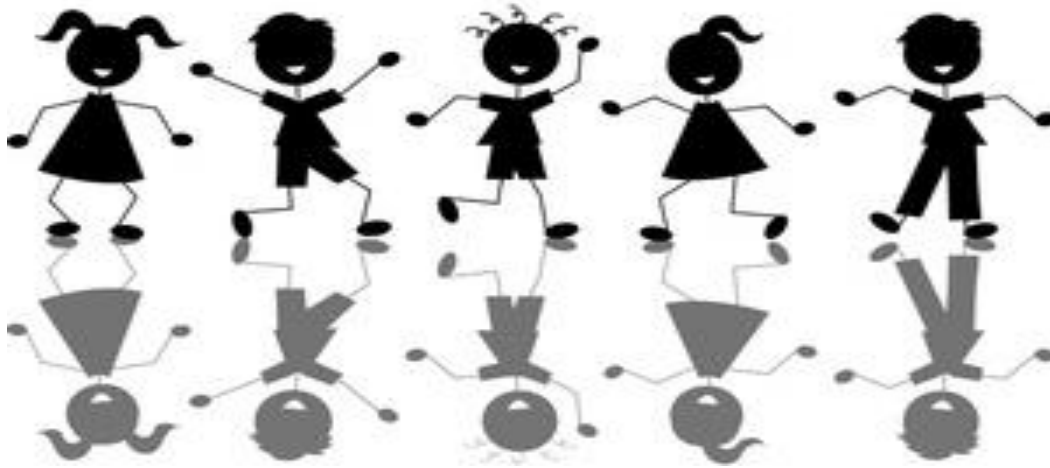

April Stewardship Reflections

“April showers bring May flowers” is an old saying that is fairly well known to adults and children as well. It is true that God blesses His creation with rain which causes seeds to sprout and grow upon the earth. This blessing of rain is something good that God lavishes upon all people. And, because of the blessing of rain, seedtime and harvest will prevail and the earth will yield its increase and provide food for all God’s creatures. Not only does rain bring forth flowers but also the fruits and grains from gardens, vineyards, orchards and fields. God is good and His mercy endures forever. His rain will come not only in April but throughout the growing season. This year of course we pray that rain would be merciful and not cause any additional flooding.

We do however, rejoice and are glad that God takes such bountiful care of our physical needs. That is important, but also in April we will celebrate a special day which reminds us that God also takes care of all our spiritual needs. That day is Easter, a day set aside to celebrate the victory of Jesus over sin, death and the devil. As the Bible teaches, because He lives we shall also live. What great, good news that is to celebrate and share with others who also need to hear some good news.

Why does God lavish such rich physical blessings upon us? Martin Luther explains it well when in the Small Catechism he wrote: **“All this He does only out of fatherly, divine goodness and mercy without any merit or worthiness in me. For all this it is my duty to thank and praise, serve and obey Him. This is most certainly true!”** Why does God lavish upon us such rich spiritual blessings because of the life, death and resurrection of Jesus? Again, in the Small Catechism Luther wrote: **“that I may be His own and live under Him in His kingdom and serve Him in everlasting righteousness, innocence and blessedness, just as He is risen from the dead, lives and reigns to all eternity. This is most certainly true!”**

God lavishes His rich blessings upon us to manage and use in ways that honor Him and bless others as well as ourselves. This is what we mean when we talk about Christian stewardship. God’s stewards freely and joyfully manage all of life and life’s resources for His purposes. This management includes taking care of God’s creation so that the physical needs of all God’s creatures are satisfied. It also includes sharing the good news of hope and salvation through Jesus who died for us and rose again.
