AUGUST MEETING 2011

The Canton Lutheran Church Executive Council met Wednesday, August 10.

The Welcome and Witness committee announced they will hold a new member Sunday, November 6. There are approximately 12 families joining the congregation. The new members will share a meal with their shepherd family the week before new member Sunday where they will meet the groups of Canton Lutheran Church. On new member Sunday, there will be a special fellowship coffee after worship to celebrate the new members.

Mission and Ministry announced they are planning a special church service to thank volunteers at CLC for December. They also reported the annual trip to Milk's Camp will be the first weekend of December.

The Stewardship Committee is working on compiling of list of projects that need to be completed around the church.

A thank you letter from ELCA World Hunger

Canton Lutheran recently received a thank you letter from the Rev. Daniel Rift, Director of ELCA World Hunger. **The excerpts below give one example of how our donations to ELCA World Hunger are used:**

“It is with a grateful heart that I am writing to thank you and your congregation...Your generosity and faithful partnership with ELCA World Hunger continues to transform a poverty stricken reality into a wellspring of life and strength for many around the world.”

“Because of your gifts a marginalized and indigenous people living in the Eastern region of Nepal have begun to experience true liberation and empowerment. In this example, the funding support is by an ELCA World Hunger grant to the Lutheran World Federation.”

“Comprised mostly of agricultural workers who do not own land and lack access to basic services and credit, communities are organizing into self-help groups and focusing on sanitation and hygiene, education and human rights...In rural Sisbanijahada, the Morang district, a Santhal community decided to focus on educating their children. Only 24% of the Santhal are able to read and write. Five years ago, none of their children were enrolled in school, and last spring, 88 were attending a Child Learning Center. Randan Murmu, a Santhal mother shared, *‘We spent our life in fear because of our lack of education. Our children will not have a life like ours because of education. LWF has helped us*

understand our rights with the district government for access to education.’”

At Canton Lutheran, one way we contribute to ELCA World Hunger is through the donations received during our coffee/fellowship time after worship services. 100% of those donations go to ELCA World Hunger and it is amazing to see how the coins and dollars add up. We thought you would like to hear one example of the impact those contributions make. **Thank you for your faithful support.**

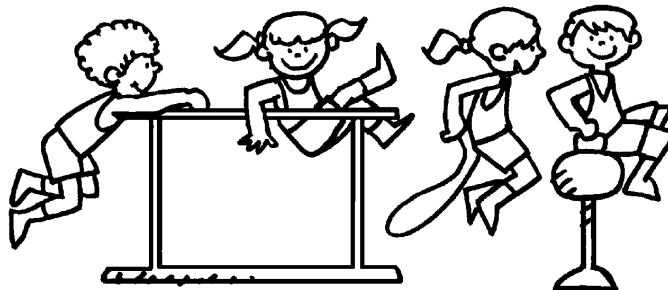

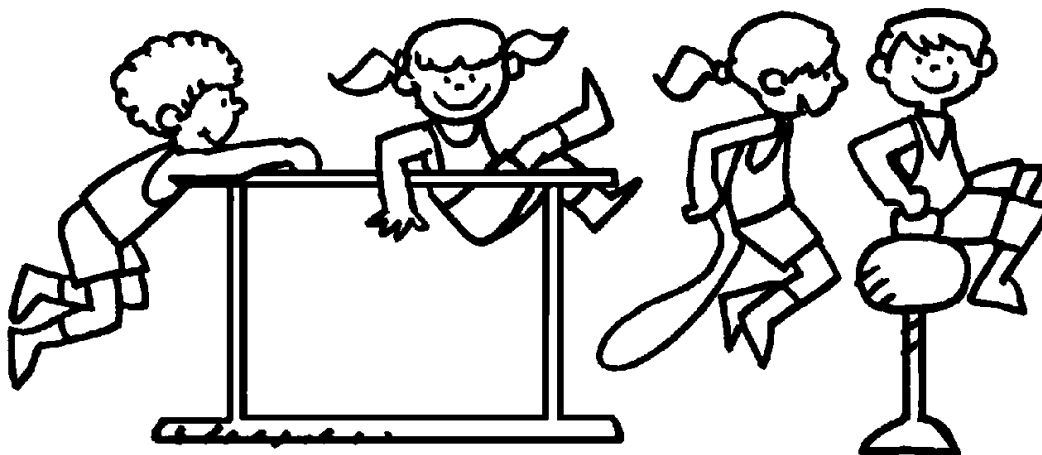
